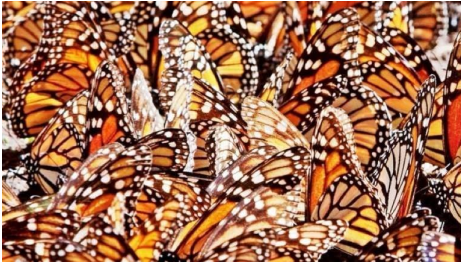

Visit the **El Rosario Monarch Butterfly Preserve**, the largest sanctuary in the state of Michoacán, where the butterflies cover about 1,500 trees. This sanctuary was declared a World Heritage Site in 2008.

Housed in a former marketplace, the **Cosmovital** in Toluca was repurposed as a botanical garden and decorated by colossal works of stained glass art that tells the story of creation.



## VISIT VALLE DE BRAVO

**Valle de Bravo** is located on the shores of Lake Avandaro, in the hills of central Mexico, about two hours west of Mexico City. The cobblestone streets and plazas of Valle have the same patented European charm as Positano or Lisbon but with a specific blend of warmth and vitality that is unique to Mexico.
